REGULATION AND LICENSING OF EQUESTRIAN TRAVEL

Section 3-2A-2. No person shall ride any driveway, roadway, path or trail within the Forest Preserves or on any territory under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners of the Forest Preserve District of Cook County, unless such person has a rider's license and a license has been issued for such horse under the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3-2A-3-A (A). (1) Applications for licenses for riders shall be made at the office of the Forest Preserve District in River Forest, Illinois, and at such other place or places designated by the General Superintendent. Applications for licenses shall be made on serially numbered forms furnished by the Forest Preserve District and shall be accompanied by the required license fee. Such applications shall state in full name, address, and brief description of the applicant who shall be a minimum of twelve years old. Licenses may be issued for riders under 12 years old but such riders must be accompanied on the trail by an adult and the license shall clearly state this limitation. Upon payment of the required fee, the General Superintendent or his deputy shall issue to each qualified applicant a rider's license. Every rider shall have in his or her immediate possession such a license at all times when riding within the Forest Preserve or the territory under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners of the Forest Preserve District of Cook County and shall display the same upon demand by any member of the Police force of the Forest Preserve District or designated deputy of the General Superintendent.

No license may be issued hereunder to any person whose license has been revoked until the expiration of the period of revocation.

Section 3-2A-8-C. (1) Riders use only such highways, trails, or paths within the Forest Preserve or territory under the jurisdiction of the District as shall be designated for equestrian travel by the Board of Commissioners of the Forest Preserve District and accordance with the ordinances of the Forest Preserve District.

(2) Riders will not be permitted within the Forest Preserve after sunset and before sunrise on any day.

Section 3-2A-12. Any person violating any clause or provision of Section 3-2A-2 thru 3-2A-9 of this Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor than \$500.00 for each offense. Any second or subsequent violation shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00. Each day a violation shall continue shall be a separate and distinct offense.
